Minister tests positive; Covid toll reaches 3,254

MINISTER food, civil supply and consumer affairs, Jayesh Rutadiya, was among 1,314 fresh cases of Covid-19 reported on Monday. Rutadiya declared this on social media stating that he got tested for the infection after experiencing mild symptoms and the test has returned positive. He added that he has got himself home quarantined and advised those who came in contact with him in the last one week to get themselves tested.

BJP MP A Him (Jamsagar) constituency Raghavi Patel also declared that he tested positive for Covid-19 on social media, while adding that he has got himself admitted to a hospital.

The state on Monday recorded as many as 17 deaths, taking the death toll to 1,254.

The state health department in an order on Monday also declared that the health workers and doctors who are in quarantine owing to Covid duty shall count the period as 'on duty'.

Meanwhile, Chief Minister Vijay Rupani tested negative for Covid-19 after he volunteered for the testing in an attempt to allay fears in people's minds about the test, said an official release Monday. Rupani has given a slogan 'Test is Best' while appealing to the people to go for the same, the release added.

On Monday, Rajkot district recorded 150 fresh cases. As many as 85 patients have succumbed to the virus while 1,484 are under treatment in Rajkot city. The test positivity rate stands at 3.43 per cent.

The Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation is now starting a targeted drive to crack down on food courts and food truck parks not adhering to Covid norms. On Sunday, a food truck park on SG Highway, opposite Ramnath Club, was sealed after it was found that 35 of its food trucks were open at the site in violation of the current norms that prohibit the same.

At the Rajkot railway station, where AMC continues to test passengers disembarking at Ahmedabad, 17 of the 1,380 arriving passengers tested positive, of whom 10 were then taken to a dedicated Covid Care Centre near the Sahamati Railway Station.

A shopping centre in Rajkot was also declared a micro containment zone.

Air, rail, road travellers entering Rajkot city to be randomly tested

WITH THE number of daily fresh Covid-19 cases in Rajkot continuing to hover around 100 for around two weeks, the Rajkot Municipal Corporation (RMC) Monday said that it would test air, rail and road travellers on a random basis from Tuesday to July to contain the spread of the contagion in the city.

Rajkot Municipal Corporation Commissioner M M Agrewal, after a meeting with local officials of the Gujarat State Road Transport Corporation (GSRTC), the Rajkot division of Western Railway and the Airport Authority of India (AAI) on Monday, announced that it was an attempt for the check body to ensure that there are no hotspots at air, rail and road stations and randomly test passengers for Covid-19.

"The positivity rate in the city is coming down and therefore, we want to focus on people coming from outside to not spread the infection. Therefore, we have decided to test passengers randomly at the railway station, the airport and bus stops," Agrewal said.

"Once we start randomly testing those coming from outside, you would see the evidence," Ahmedabad adopted a similar strategy and we are following it," Rajmad, Rajkot-Okha train, scheduled to arrive at Rajkot railway station on Tuesday, will be the first passenger train to arrive in Rajkot in four months. Similarly, the SpiceJet flight from Mumbai also landed at Rajkot airport after a similar gap. This week, the number of flights from the city is going up to 19 per week. A new flight from Rajkot to Delhi has also been added to the schedule.

"Some 58 passengers are to be boarded the train at Rajkot railway station and we shall set up a booth there to test passengers randomly. We have requested space for our health team at the airport and bus stop will become operational from Tuesday. However, setting up booths for testing is coming by the way would take two to three days," Agrewal said.

The Rajkot division of the GSRTC has been operating around 750 routes daily, ferrying around 25,000 passengers. "But mostly, these routes cover Sabarmati and districts like Ahmedabad and Vadodra. Our only routes covering destinations outside Gujarat are to Rajkot and Diu, and that too only five trips. So, we shall not test full support to the RMC in testing our passengers randomly," said Yogesh Patel, divisional controller of GSRTC in Rajkot.

"We have given thermal guns to 50 bus conductors who serve on rural routes in Gujarat. Similarly, 25 depots in our division have also been given thermal guns to screen passengers before they are allowed to board buses," added the divisional controller.

NAFED to procure groundnut at MSP from Oct 21: Minister

THE NATIONAL Agricultural Cooperative Marketing Federation of India Ltd (NAFED) will begin procurement of groundnut in Gujarat from October 21, R C Faldus, state agriculture minister, said on Monday.

"From October 21, NAFED will begin procurement of groundnut based on the Minimum Support Price. This buying process will be held for 90 days as per the Government of India's norms," said the minister. Faldus said the registration process for the farmers will be on till October 1 and will go on till October 20. The Food and Civil Supplies department of the government will be the nodal agency for the procurement.

The state government earlier announced that it will begin the procurement after Diwali. The change in dates has been made after representations were made by farmers. The Gujarat government's first advance estimate has projected groundnut crop at all time high of Rs 5465 lakh nose for Kharif 2020. The government will be done at a MSP of Rs 1055 for 20kg. The central government agency will be procuring the groundnuts at a time when farmers in the state have suffered extensive damage due to continuous rainfall this monsoon.

Crop loss survey over
R C Faldus, state agriculture minister, said that crops over an estimated 13 lakh hectares, would have got damaged this monsoon due to excessive rainfall. "So far, survey has been completed in 3 lakh hectares and the line of the survey will be extended," said the minister. He said apart from groundnut, the government will also buy pulses at MSP.

The government is looking to compensate farmers affected by rainfall under the State Disaster Response Fund, as existing provisions if the newly-launched Mukhyamantri Kisan Sahay Yojana does not cover any region. This Yojana was launched after the government accepted the tenders for the crop insurance scheme Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY).

Cloth, grain markets join Rajkot jewellers in voluntary lockdown

HOURS AFTER the Dhwangpara cloth market and the Danapith grain market announced that they are joining the jewellery market in the Soti Bazar area of Rajkot city in a self-imposed lockdown, in view of the rising cases of Covid-19, the Rajkot Chamber of Commerce and Industry (RCCI) on Monday convened a meeting of its member associations and announced that it was not in favour of a lockdown.

"Our members are coming to their shops and interacting with customers, despite being unwell. There is panic in other members that they might contract the virus. We posted a proposal to our WhatsApp group today to keep our shops closed for a week from Tuesday onwards. So far, around 85 per cent members have agreed with the proposal," said Dinesh Bhatt, president of Dhwangpara Association.

"Members who are opposed to the proposal are free to keep their shops open. But the majority have decided to open shops for a week and try to break the chain of infection," Dhanraj said. "Danapith traders will also keep shops closed till Monday."

RCCI president V P Vagharia said, "We held a virtual meeting, attended by 57 persons representing 48 member associations. The dominant view was that traders' financial condition has already weakened due to the long lockdown. Therefore, we decided that any lockdown was not advisable now. However, associations were free to take a call independently in this matter."
